#### General Education Notes:

- Please review the Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog for General Education Requirements (GER).
- Since the students following this articulation agreement will complete the A.A. General Education Requirements at Florida State College at Jacksonville (during the '15 semester hours of bridge coursework') they will satisfy the Gordon Rule requirements for Florida State College at Jacksonville and UNF. Additional upper level Gordon Rule coursework may be required for certain majors.
- All General Education courses require a grade of "C" or above.
- CLAS (College Level Academic Skills): Satisfaction of these skills is a graduation requirement for the bachelor's degree in the state college and state university systems of Florida. Students must meet one of the approved exemptions – see the catalog for more information. **Students are strongly encouraged to satisfy the CLAS prior to transferring to UNF, however satisfying the CLAS is not a requirement prior to matriculation into the BS ASL/English Interpreting program at UNF under this agreement.**

### **Prerequisite Notes:**

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both Florida State College at Jacksonville General Education Requirements and UNF Major Prerequisites.  
Please review the General Education Requirements and talk with an advisor.
- Foreign Language Requirement: Students who have not completed two years of sequential foreign language study or American Sign Language in high school must complete 8 hours of college level foreign language or American Sign Language at Florida State College at Jacksonville. If this requirement is not completed at Florida State College at Jacksonville, it must be completed at UNF prior to graduation.

### **Admissions Notes:**

- Florida State College at Jacksonville: Students must pass the PACE proficiency entrance exam for American Sign Language prior to admission to the AS Sign Language Interpretation program.
- UNF: Students must mail, separate from their application, a letter to the UNF Program Director of Sign Language in which they detail the reasons for seeking admission to the degree program. Particular emphasis should be placed on identification of the student’s professional goals and objectives. This letter should be submitted no later than the transfer admissions application deadline for the term in which the student would like to matriculate.
- UNF: Students who do not meet the minimum admissions requirements for the UNF College of Education and Human Services and are officially denied admission may submit a letter of appeal of the admissions decision.

### **Other Notes:**

- Students must complete the Information Literacy Assessment requirement prior to graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville.
- Qualified students will have earned a grade point average of 2.0 and will have completed the coursework specified in the transfer advising sheet. (GPA is based on all previous college or university course work).
- Students who complete their Florida State College at Jacksonville course work under the terms of the catalog in effect during the term of their registration must graduate within five years or they will automatically be reassigned to the catalog in effect during their fifth year.
- Upon completion of the AS degree, students must maintain continuous enrollment and transfer directly to UNF within two semesters of the last term of enrollment at Florida State College at Jacksonville. Continuous enrollment is defined as enrollment not interrupted by non-attendance for more than two semesters.
- Any waiver or substitution of coursework at either institution must have prior approval by the appropriate institution.
- UNF requires a minimum of 48 semester hours of upper division coursework in order to establish Bachelor of Science graduation eligibility. At UNF, students must have a minimum grade of “C” in all courses in the UNF ASL/English Interpreting major. Only two courses in which a student receives a grade of less than “C,” “P,” or “WP” may be repeated prior to dismissal from the program.
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.
