FOR EXCELLENCE IN INSTRUCTION SUPPORTING HEALTH CARE AND
NATURAL SCIENCES**

Purpose

This award recognizes the outstanding contributions of a faculty member whose actions directly impact students seeking a career in health care. The impact of student learning outcomes at all stages of educational attainment will be considered.

Eligibility

Full-time faculty. Joint proposals will not be reviewed or awarded.

Application Portfolio

The application portfolio must include:

- A brief (no more than three double-spaced pages) narrative description of the candidate's accomplishments in college instructional innovation and student learning. Include supporting evidence of activities in one or more of the following categories:
 - Service to the community in the area of continuing education programs in health care.
 - Innovation in areas such as teaching, recruitment, or developing programs.
 - Service to applicant's program or discipline.
- Letters of support from three people who have worked with the candidate. Letters should support the candidate's efforts in supporting student success.
- The candidate's curriculum vitae.

Application Submission

Application portfolio will be submitted to the Office of the Associate Vice President of Liberal Arts annually. Specific timelines will be announced each fall semester.

Nominating Committee

The nominating committee consists of faculty members appointed by the Executive Vice President for Instruction & Student Services working in cooperation with The Center of the Advancement of Teaching and Learning.

Award(s)

- \$1,000
- For those who put forth a presentation proposal, to the National Institute for Staff and Organizational Development (NISOD) conference costs will be paid for by the College. The proposal does not have to be accepted.
- Recognition during convocation the year in which the award is given
