How to Access Information Literacy Assessment Preparation Materials

To access the **Information Literacy Assessment preparation materials** for the first time:

1. Log on to [Blackboard](#)
2. Click on the **Community** tab
3. Click on **Students** (or Faculty) under **Organization Catalog**
4. Find **Information Literacy** and click on the “**Enroll**” button at the far right end of the line. There is no fee for enrolling in the course.
5. Click **Submit**
6. Click **Okay**
7. When the course opens, click on the “**Announcements**” button on the left side of the screen to read important information.
8. Click on the “**Modules 1-6**” button to access the course modules. Studying these modules will prepare you for the Information Literacy Assessment.
9. Now that you are enrolled, in future use you will be able to access the **Information Literacy** preparation materials directly in Blackboard from a link in the **Organization Catalog** under the **Community** tab.

Note: You may see a section called “**My Organizations**” on the first screen that opens when you log on to Blackboard (“My FCCJ”); once you have enrolled, this section will provide a direct link to the Information Literacy material, bypassing the Community tab. If “My Organizations” is not displaying on the “My FCCJ” screen of Blackboard, you can use the “Modify Content” button at the top right of the Blackboard screen to select “My Organizations” from the list of options.
