This transfer institution has agreed to accept the specified associate’s degree from FCCJ. The FCCJ graduate will be accepted at the junior level, and is required to complete the equivalent of two years of full-time coursework to complete the specified bachelor’s degree. The following chart shows the specific courses that the FCCJ student is required to take to meet the guidelines of the articulation agreement with the transfer institution.

It is very important to make sure that your Program of Study at FCCJ is Associate of Science in Interior Design. If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.

Students wanting to transfer to FSU to receive a bachelor’s degree in Interior Design must complete the following:

- a. Associate in Science degree in Interior Design
- b. Associate in Arts general education certification
- c. Pass the CLAST examination
- d. A minimum **3.0** grade point average
- e. Pass FSU’s portfolio review

**General Education Notes:**

- Please review the Florida Community College Catalog for General Education Requirements (GER). Total number of General Education hours could vary depending on the specific courses chosen by the student.
- Students will complete additional General Education courses at FCCJ, through the bridge program, before transferring to FSU. “A.A. General Education Requirements have been met” must be stamped on student transcript.
- CLAST (College Level Academic Skills Test): The CLAST is a graduation requirement for the bachelor’s degree in the state university system of Florida. Passing all four subsets of the CLAST exam, or satisfying a CLAST exemption, is a

requirement for meeting the bachelor's degree graduation requirement. For this articulation agreement with FSU, students must take and pass the CLAST while at the community college.

- Foreign Language Requirement for Bachelor of Science in Interior Design option: Students who have not completed two years of sequential foreign language study or American Sign Language in high school must complete 8 hours of college level foreign language or American Sign Language at FCCJ. If this requirement is not completed at FCCJ, it must be completed at FSU prior to graduation.
- Foreign Language Requirement for Bachelor of Arts in Interior Design option: Students who plan to earn the B. A. degree must complete a foreign language through the intermediate (2200 or equivalent) level and nine additional hours in the fields of history and humanities.
- All General Education courses require a grade of "C" or above.

**Prerequisite and Elective Notes:**

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of "C" or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both FCCJ General Education Requirements and FSU Major Prerequisites. Please review the General Education Requirements and talk with an advisor.
- Professional Electives to be chosen from an approved list in FCCJ Catalog

**Other Notes:**

- Qualified students will have earned a grade point average of **3.0** for all course work at FCCJ and will have completed a minimum of 70 semester hours before transferring.
- No more than 92 semester hours of credit may be transferred toward completion of the degree requirements at FSU.
- Students who complete their FCCJ course work under the terms of the catalog in effect during the term of their registration must graduate within five years or they will automatically be reassigned to the catalog in effect during their fifth year.
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.
